SAFETY GUIDANCE

The safety of our team and guests is of paramount importance.

To ensure we all keep safe please see to follow our new guidance.

- Babbacombe Inn will be operating table service you have come to enjoy inside and outside - you must be 'seated' to be served. Face masks are required for entry and must be worn whilst moving around the premises. Please observe social distancing & follow our signage. Face masks can be removed whilst seated only.
- We will be closing at 10pm every evening, the bar will be closed from 9.30pm and we respectfully ask all customers to leave the premises by 10pm. We kindly ask for all taxis to be ordered for collection before 10pm.
- We are taking bookings for diners only at this time but will have some seating available for walk ins. Please plan ahead to avoid disappointment.
- Table reservations are for 2 hours. Please arrive as prompt to your reservation slot as possible so you can enjoy your maximum time with us. Your party size is restricted to no more than 6 people.
- We have created one-way systems for entry, exit and toilet access. Please wait to be seated and observe social distancing should you need to queue.
- Our furniture has been placed to provide adequate space for social distancing – please do not move chairs or tables.
- Please respect social distancing when moving through the Babbacombe Inn.
- Hand sanitiser points will be available throughout & we will be following a robust cleaning system.
- We are encouraging card payments please to reduce risk to our team, please use contactless wherever possible.
- Our menus and ordering can be done either via our 'order at table' software or a single use paper copy which will be brought to your table.
- Our team will be washing their hands regularly and will be provided with the correct PPE for the duty they are performing.
- Our teams have been trained to operate in the safest way possible
- If you are feeling unwell, have symptoms of corona virus, or a member of your household is, please do not visit us & let us know at your earliest convenience.
- Failure to observe safety measures will result in service not being provided.
- These measures will be under constant review and subject to change pending Government guidance.

We ask all our guests to be respectful of these policies when they visit us.

How test and trace helps fight the virus

The NHS test and trace service will help to control the rate of reproduction (R), reduce the spread of the infection and save lives. By playing your part through the actions set out below, you will directly help to contain the virus by reducing its spread. This means that, thanks to your efforts, we will be able to go as far as it is safe to go in easing lockdown measures.

You can help in the following ways:

- if you develop symptoms, you must continue to follow the rules to self-isolate with other members of your household and order a test to find out if you have coronavirus
- if you test positive for coronavirus, you must share information promptly about your recent contacts through the NHS test and trace service to help us alert other people who may need to self-isolate
- if you have had close recent contact with someone who has coronavirus, you must self-isolate if the NHS test and trace service advises you to do so
